Overview of the Distribution Box A distribution box (DB), also called a distribution board, is the central hub where electrical power is divided into multiple circuits for a building. It contains protective devices such as MCBs (Miniature Circuit Breakers), RCCBs (Residual Current Circuit Breakers), and sometimes fuses, which safeguard against overloads, short circuits, and leakage currents. The main power supply enters the DB through a main MCB or isolator, and from there, power is distributed to individual circuits, including lighting, outlets, and appliances.

Wiring a Light Switch A light switch controls the flow of electricity to a light fixture. The wiring typically involves:

- Phase (live) wire:** Runs from the distribution box through the MCB to the switch, then to the light fixture.
- Neutral wire:** Usually connected directly from the DB to the light fixture, bypassing the switch.
- Earth wire:** Connected to the fixture and the DB earth link for safety.

In a standard single-pole switch setup, the phase wire is interrupted by the switch, allowing the light to be turned on or off, while the neutral remains continuous. For multiple lights or advanced setups, additional wiring configurations like switch loops or two-way switches may be used.

Safety Considerations Turn off the main breaker before working on any wiring to prevent electric shock. Use a non-contact voltage tester to confirm wires are de-energized. Ensure proper earthing of all metallic parts and fixtures. Select MCB and RCCB ratings appropriate for the lighting load to prevent overloads and leakage hazards. Use insulated tools, wire nuts, and electrical tape for secure connections.

Practical Connection Steps Identify the output MCB in the DB for the lighting circuit. Connect the phase wire from the MCB output to one terminal of the switch. Connect the other terminal of the switch to the light fixture's phase input. Connect the neutral wire from the DB neutral link directly to the light fi...
