MPO stands for “Multi-Fiber Push-On,” a multi-fiber array connector defined by IEC 61754-7 and TIA-604-5 (FOCIS-5). It uses a rectangular MT ferrule (about 6.5 mm) that can hold multiple fibers (commonly 8, 12, 16, 24, and higher counts). The MTP/MPO is a low-loss multifiber connector with a maximum of up to 72 fibres, based on n x 12-fiber MT ferrules, with cable ports and bend protection for round cables. Usually, one MTP®/MPO connector has 8, 12, 16, 24 or 32 fibers, which makes these fiber cables perfect for applications that require huge bandwidths.
