- Modular inlet systems**, such as the KRASO KDS 150, enable expansion to multiple rows and integration with other utility lines like water or telecommunication, especially in buildings without basements.

Installation Best Practices

- Placement:** Install the distribution box near the load center to minimize cable length and reduce power loss.
- Sealing:** Ensure all cable inlets and cover joints are tightly sealed to prevent water ingress and maintain safety.
- Height and accessibility:** Typically, the bottom edge of the box is installed 1.5-1.8 meters above the ground for convenient operation and inspection.
- Wiring standards:** Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas matching the load current. Properly label and secure all cables.
- Grounding:** The metal enclosure, internal installation board, and connected appliances must be reliably grounded, with protective neutral wires connected through terminal boards.
