Modular designs with proper cable glands and terminals facilitate safe installation and maintenance . Electrical and Load Requirements All electrical components must comply with relevant standards, maintaining proper clearance, creepage distances, and withstand voltage under normal operating conditions . Distribution boxes should support the voltage and current requirements of connected equipment to prevent overheating or electrical faults . Wiring should be organized, with fasteners and secondary wiring using corrosion-resistant materials, and layered distribution boxes should consider trunking for neat cable management . Enclosure Ratings and Protection Types Explosion-proof boxes are classified by protection type (e.g., Ex d for flameproof, Ex tb for dust protection) and IP ratings to ensure resistance to dust, wa...
