Fiberglass Reinforced Plastic (FRP) FRP trays are non-conductive, highly corrosion-resistant, and suitable for harsh chemical or marine environments. They are ideal for areas where electrical conductivity must be minimized or where exposure to moisture, chemicals, or UV radiation is significant. FRP is lightweight and easy to handle, but it has a higher initial cost compared to steel or aluminum.

Plastic Cable Trays Plastic trays, typically made from PVC, are completely corrosion-proof and lightweight, but they are generally limited to light-duty applications due to lower mechanical strength. They are suitable for small-scale outdoor installations where heavy loads or mechanical stress are not a concern.
