

Methods for Installing Fiber Optic Cables on Telecommunication Towers

Employ torsion compensating elements like turning shackles to avoid twisting during vertical lifts.

Securing the Cable Fix the cable to the tower using clamps with appropriate diameters, ensuring it does not touch the structure directly. For vertical runs, secure at intervals of 0.8–1 meter, and for horizontal runs, every 1 meter. At entry and exit points, use adequate fastening to prevent contact with monopole openings. Remove cable ties, installation tubes, and protective films only after the cable is fully installed and clamped.

Stringing and Termination Use a winch or pulling mechanism to string the cable between tower points, maintaining proper tension to prevent sagging. For fiber trunk cables, dismount protective tubes just before connecting to the mast box or distributor casing. Clean the ferrules of fiber optic connectors before attaching to adapters to e...
