

Methods for connecting wires to a construction site electrical distribution box

Cable Types and Routing Overhead cables should be robust, pliable, and preferably armoured with insulating sheaths, supported on cable stands to minimize obstruction. Underground cables must be armoured PVC or mineral-insulated copper-clad (MICC) cables, buried at safe depths, and clearly marked on site plans. Distribution cabling can be multi-strand, multi-core flexible PVC cables, arranged neatly inside the box to prevent tangling and allow heat dissipation.
