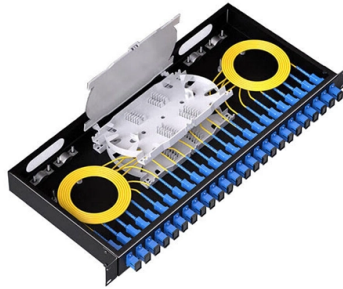


Mini-module cable tray installation process

Ensure vertical and horizontal alignment using spirit levels or laser levels (). Avoid placing splice plates over supports or mid-span; ideally, splice joints should fall between supports or at quarter points (). Drill holes for splice plates using the plate as a template, then align trays and supports before permanently fastening ().

Splicing and Fastening Use manufacturer-approved bolts, nuts, and fasteners to secure trays (). Ensure all trays are properly bonded to the main earthing system using copper wire for continuity (). Maintain segregation of power, data, and control cables and apply color coding if required ().
