

National Standard for Wiring Colors in Electrical Control Cabinets



AI Overview

In electrical control cabinets, wiring colors are standardized to ensure safety and clear identification: protective earth is green-yellow, neutral is light blue, AC power is black, AC control is red, and DC control is blue, following NEN-EN-IEC 61439 and IEC 60445 guidelines.

Key Wiring Color Standards

- Protective Earth (PE):** The protective conductor must be green-yellow throughout its length. In control cabinets, if the wire is clearly identifiable, marking at accessible points or connection ends is sufficient, though full-length coding is recommended for safety.
- Neutral Conductor:** The neutral wire is light blue and should not be used for any other function to avoid confusion.
- AC and DC Power Conductors:**
 - Black:** AC and DC main power chains
 - Red:** AC control circuits
 - Blue (dark blue):** DC control circuits
 - Orange:** Power chains that may remain live when the main switch is off (e.g., potential-free contacts leaving the cabinet).

Exceptions and Flexibility: While these colors are recommended, exceptions are allowed if insulation materials in the specified colors are unavailable, particularly in multi-core cables. Alternative identification methods such as terminal numbering, wire markers, or functional labels are permitted under IEC 60445, provided each conductor is clearly traceable.

Three-Phase Systems: For installations outside the cabinet, NEN 1010 prescribes brown, black, and gray for the three-phase conductors, with blue for neutral and green-yellow for earth. Inside the control cabinet, the NEN-EN-IEC 61439 standard is less stringent, allowing partial coding if the wire ends are clearly visible.

Practical Considerations

- Labeling:** Even when color coding is used, consistent labeling of wires ensures compliance and reduces misidentification risks.
- Voltage Type:** The choice of color may depend on whether the circuit is AC or DC, and whether it is a main power or control circuit.
