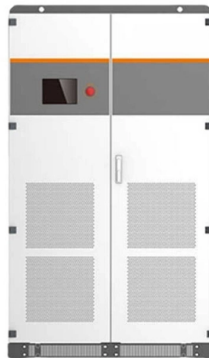


No network connection on fiber optic panel

A fiber optic panel showing no network is often caused by physical damage, dirty connectors, incorrect SFP modules, or misconfigured switches, and can be resolved through systematic inspection and testing.

Step 1: Inspect Physical Connections Check all fiber cables for visible damage such as cuts, sharp bends, or kinks, and ensure connectors are fully seated in the panel and devices. Maintain the minimum bend radius to prevent signal loss. Verify that transmit (Tx) and receive (Rx) fibers are correctly connected, as reversed polarity can prevent network traffic even if link lights are on.

Step 2: Clean and Test Connectors Dirty or contaminated connectors are a common cause of network failure. Use a fiber inspection microscope to examine the endfaces and clean them with lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol or a one-click fiber cleaner. Ensure both ends of the connection are clean and pass inspection standards.

Step 3: Verify SFP Modules and Switches Ensure that SFP modules are compatible with the switches and fiber type (single-mode or multimode). Swap suspect SFPs with known-good units to rule out module failure. Check that switches are powered and functioning correctly, and consider using a managed switch if troubleshooting with dumb switches is insufficient.

Step 4: Test Signal Strength Use an optical power meter or OTDR to measure signal loss along the fiber. Values outside the typical range (-15 dBm to -30 dBm) indicate a problem with the fiber link. This helps identify hidden issues such as microbends or connector degradation.

Step 5: Check Network Configuration Even if the physical link is active, configuration errors can prevent network traffic. Verify IP settings, DHCP availability, and ensure no duplicate IPs or rogue DHCP servers are present. For static testing, assign a manual IP to a device and attempt to ping across the link.
