Test Signal Strength If the physical connections and configuration appear correct, use an optical power meter or OTDR to measure signal strength. Values outside the typical range (around -15dBm to -30dBm) may indicate a problem with the fiber line itself . Persistent low signal may require contacting your ISP to check for line issues or provisioning errors.
