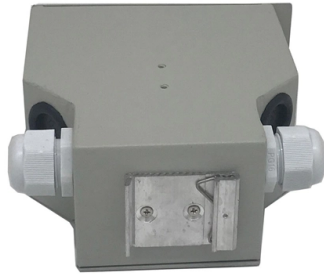


Nordic tunnel bridge specifications



Overview

The bridge connecting Sweden and the Danish island of Amager spans a length of 7,845 meters, covering half the distance between the two countries. It is a substantial structure with a weight of 82,000 tonnes, supporting two railway tracks and functioning as a four-lane road bridge. Designed by Jørgen Nissen, Klaus Falbe Hansen from Ove Arup & Partners, along with Niels Gimsing and Georg Rotne, construction of the. The Øresund Bridge or Öresund Bridge is a combined railway and motorway cable-stayed bridge across the Øresund strait between Denmark and Sweden. It includes, in succession, a tunnel, an artificial island, a viaduct, a cable-stayed bridge, and a second viaduct. The infrastructure, which as a whole extends over a distance of 16 kilometres and. Over the years, there have been several proposals for a fixed link across the strait. One of the most radical was to dam the strait and then pump out the water to create land for development. Ideas for a fixed link across the Øresund were advanced as early as the late 1800s. And in 1910, proposals were put to the Swedish Parliament for a railway tunnel across the strait, which would have comprised two tunnelled sections
