- China:** Leads in fiber deployment with over 59.6 million kilometers of fiber lines installed. Major operators like China Mobile, China Telecom, and China Unicom use SDH and DWDM technologies to transmit high volumes of data across the country.
- Japan, South Korea, Singapore, and Vietnam:** High adoption of fiber-to-the-home (FTTH) services, with Japan alone having 36.6 million FTTH subscribers. These networks are being upgraded to support higher transmission speeds and expand coverage to remote areas.
- Emerging APAC markets:** Indonesia, Thailand, Malaysia, and the Philippines are expanding fiber broadband through prepaid FTTH packages and 5G integration, using modern fiber optic systems to increase accessibility.
