In contrast to an active optical network (AON), which connects various users to a single transceiver through a fiber optic branching tree and passive splitter/combiner unit, a PON is different in that the network operates only in the optical domain and does not require power. Without pigtails, every termination in an ODF, terminal box, or splice closure would require field-installed connectors—an approach. The ONU, a key device in a PON (Passive Optical Network), converts optical signals into electrical ones for users. It comes with various ports to suit different needs.
