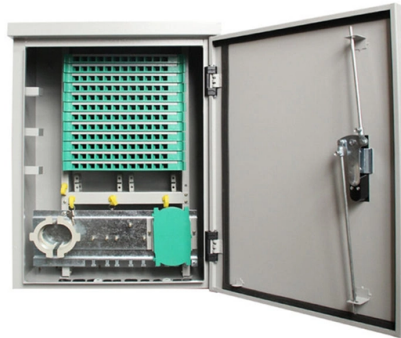

3. Support and Fixing: Install supports, hangers, and brackets according to manufacturer recommendations. Ensure vertical and horizontal alignment using spirit levels or laser tools. Supports should be spaced to maintain structural integrity and accommodate cable weight.
