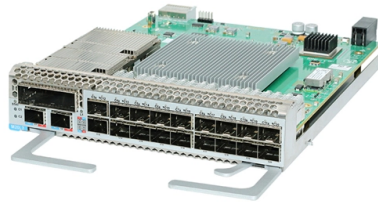


Optical module cannot negotiate speed



Overview

SFP+ links do not auto-negotiate speed or duplex. If the link partner isn't set to 10 Gbps full-duplex explicitly, no link forms. Verify module is fully seated (you should). The optical module cannot be properly identified and optical module information cannot be obtained. After an optical module is inserted, the console port displays alarm information. Auto-negotiation turned off when inserting SFP+ transceiver in port

For dual-rate optic modules, the negotiation of the speed is handled by the module itself. You should be able to change the advertised speed to only link with partners that will support that

10G BASE-T SFPs cannot negotiate to 1GB on QFX5120-48YM

The SFP-10G can only have 10G speed on the switch side; it will auto-negotiate at 1g on the line side, but it cannot do AN (auto-negotiation) on the switch side and will always run at 10G XFI

Can 10G SFP run at 1G?

No, a 10G SFP (small form-factor pluggable) module cannot run at 1G. The SFP module operates at a specific speed and cannot be downgraded to run at a slower speed. If a 1G connection
