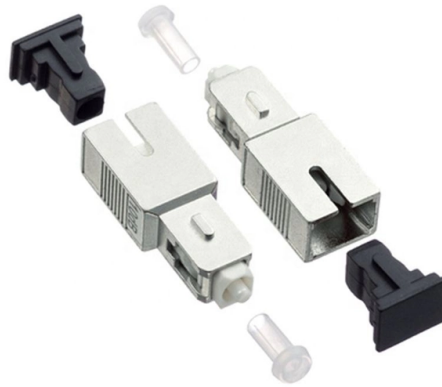


Optical module replacement transceiver
