Used in high-voltage transmission lines (110kV–800kV) for both communication and lightning protection. Designed for long-term outdoor durability, high mechanical strength, and EMI resistance.
- Loose-Tube and Ribbon Fiber Designs** Loose-tube cables contain individual fibers in buffer tubes, ideal for aerial and duct installations. Ribbon cables offer high fiber density and enable mass-fusion splicing, simplifying installation and restoration.
