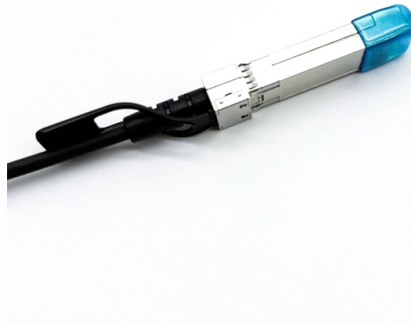


Outdoor cable tray elevation
