Key Steps in Full Inspection Select the Appropriate Inspection Tool Automated inspection scopes (e.g., FI-7000 FiberInspector Pro) provide PASS/FAIL certification according to IEC 61300-3-35 standards, highlighting defects in red (fail) or green (pass) and storing images for documentation. Manual inspection probes allow technicians to focus, center, and capture fiber end-face images, then grade them according to IEC standards. Wide-field video microscopes are recommended for MPO connectors to view the entire ferrule and connector body, identifying contamination that could transfer during mating. Connector Preparation Inspect connectors before cleaning to determine if cleaning is necessary. Use dry cleaning first with mechanical cleaners; if contamination persists, apply hybrid cleaning (wet solvent followed by dry swab) to remove stubborn debris. Inspection Procedure Connect the probe tip to the fiber connector. Adjust magnification and focus to center the fiber core. Capture the image and analyze for defects such as scratches, chips, or dirt. Automated systems can generate a full certification report in seconds, while manual inspection requires visual grading. Pass/Fail Evaluation Defects are evaluated against IEC 61300-3-35 standards. Red areas indicate failure; green areas indicate acceptable end-face quality. For multi-fiber connectors, all fibers must pass;...
