The jacket also helps resist moisture, abrasion, and chemical exposure.
- 4. Connectors** Connectors terminate the fiber ends and allow easy connection to devices or patch panels. Common types include LC, SC, FC, ST, MPO/MTP, and hybrid configurations. Connectors can be simplex (single fiber) or duplex (two fibers for bidirectional communication). Connector choice depends on device compatibility, density requirements, and network type.
- 5. Optional Features** Armored or waterproof layers for harsh environments; Uniboot or high-density designs for space-saving in data centers; Pre-terminated multi-core assemblies for rapid deployment.
