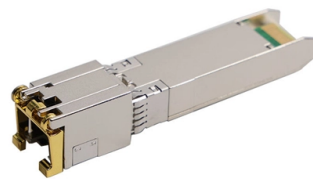


Place the aggregation switch in the low-voltage box

- 5. Cable Management** Organize network and power cables to prevent strain on connectors and maintain signal integrity. Use labeled cable paths, tie-downs, and separation of power and data lines to reduce interference, similar to the structured wiring in PV combiner boxes.
- 6. Compliance and Safety** Only qualified personnel should perform the installation, following local...
