SFP and Combo Ports Many PoE switches include SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) ports for fiber-optic connections, allowing longer-distance or high-speed network links. Combo ports combine a Gigabit Ethernet port and an SFP port, giving flexibility to use either copper or fiber connections depending on network requirements.
