

Protection requirements for power distribution boxes on construction sites

Main power distribution boxes on construction sites must be rugged, weatherproof, properly grounded, and equipped with GFCI protection to comply with OSHA and NEC standards. Wiring and Circuit Protection Temporary wiring must comply with NEC Article 590 and OSHA 29 CFR 1926 Subpart K, ensuring conductors are rated for site conditions and protected from physical damage. Feeders should originate from a central distribution center, and conductors can be run in raceways, multiconductor cables, or open conductors on insulators, provided they are not exposed to damage. Lighting and power circuits should be separated to prevent overload propagation, and color-coded wiring is recommended for easy identification.
