4. Reinforcement and Strength Members
 - FRP: Lightweight, non-conductive, suitable for indoor use ().
 - Steel Wires: Provide tensile strength for aerial or outdoor installations ().
 - Figure-8 Design: Combines fiber protection and self-supporting capability for overhead deployment ().
5. Cable Jacket Material
 - LSZH: Flame-retardant, low smoke, ideal for indoor safety ().
 - HDPE or UV-Resistant Jackets: For outdoor durability and protection against environmental stress ().
6. Termination Method
 - Fusion Splicing: Offers low insertion loss and high reliability, ideal for permanent installations ().
