Distribution boxes should be marked with standardized graphical symbols, handling instructions, weight, dimensions, and origin to ensure safe and compliant transport and storage. Graphical Symbols Standardized graphical symbols are recommended to convey handling instructions clearly, especially when language barriers exist. ISO 780:2015 specifies symbols for distribution packaging that indicate handling, storage, and transport requirements. These symbols include instructions such as “Fragile,” “Keep Dry,” “This Side Up,” and “Handle with Care” and are intended to reduce damage and mismanagement during the distribution process. Symbols should be used only when necessary and applied in a legible and durable manner. Handling and Storage Instructions Markings should clearly indicate special handling requirements, including whether the package is suitable for machine handling or requires manual handling. “Handling marks” help ensure that personnel take appropriate care during transport and storage. The markings should be visible, with high contrast (e.g., black symbols on a white background) and can be applied directly to the package or on adhesive labels. Weight and Dimensions Packages should display gross weight and dimensions in centimeters. For very heavy packages (e.g., over 1,000 kg), weight marking is mandatory, but it is recommended to indicate weight for lighter packages as well to facilitate safe handling. Country of Origin The country of origin must be stated according to the regulations of the destination country. This is often mandatory for customs purposes and should match the shipping documentation. Military and Government Standards For U.S. Department of Defense (DoD) or Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) shipments, additional markings are required: MIL-STD-129R specifies item identification markings, including barcodes (Code 39 or PDF417) for machine readability. Labels must be water-resistant and durable, often using ASTM D5486 Type I, Class 2 tape for waterproofing. Wood packaging materials must be he...
