Environmental and Installation Requirements Level 3 distribution boxes must be installed in dry, well-ventilated, and temperature-controlled locations. Level 3 boxes are typically movable or fixed final junction boxes that connect directly to electrical appliances, with the leakage protection switch installed at this level.

Protective Device Requirements Level 3 distribution boxes must include MCBs, RCDs, or RCBOs to protect against overload, short-circuit, and leakage currents. The principle of “one machine, one switch, one leakage, one box, one lock” must be strictly followed, ensuring that each switchgear controls only one electrical device or socket. The internal layout should accommodate busbars, neutral bars, earth bars, DIN rails, and surge protective devices as needed for the specific application.
