It defines requirements for arc-rated (AR) FR clothing based on incident energy levels (cal/cm^2). The protective clothing selected for the corresponding hazard/risk category number shall have an appropriate arc thermal protective value (ATPV). Flame-resistant (FR) materials and arc-rated fabrics are designed to self-extinguish and insulate the wearer against high temperatures, such as in welding environments.
