

Requirements for Setting Up Primary Distribution Boxes on Construction Sites

- Grounding and Electrical Continuity** Metal enclosures, raceways, and cable armor must be electrically continuous and connected to all boxes and fittings .Proper grounding is essential to prevent electrical shock and reduce the risk of arc flash .
- Overcurrent Protection** Temporary feeders and branch circuits must have overcurrent protection per NEC 240.4 and 240.5 .GFCI protection is required for receptacles in damp or wet locations .
- Installation Practices** Distribution boxes should be mounted off the ground to prevent water intrusion .Cables entering and leaving the box must pass through insulating bushings to prevent abrasion .Layout should separate lighting and power circuits to avoid overloads and allow easy identification with color-coded cords .Only authorized personnel should remove covers or perform maintenance .
