- Routing:** Use protective tubing or inner ducts for indoor cables, and avoid sharp bends or tight knots.
- Connection:** Clean connectors before plugging into patch panels, switches, or ONTs to prevent signal attenuation.
- Testing:** After installation, test the fiber optic link to ensure proper operation and minimal attenuation.
