Planning Wire Entry When preparing a distribution box, reserve sufficient space for incoming and outgoing wires to avoid overcrowding and ensure easy access for maintenance. For surface conduit entry, the connection between the conduit and the box must be tight and secure, using locknuts to prevent wires from being exposed. Wire Protection and Insulation Wire entry holes should be smooth and burr-free, and metal panels should be fitted with insulating bushings to prevent abrasion and short circuits. Ensure that all wires are properly insulated and that the bending radius for curves or corners is at least six times the outer diameter of the wire to maintain integrity and prevent damage. Organizing and Bundling Wires Inside the box, wires should be neatly arranged and tied into bundles. Horizontal and vertical runs should be straight and aesthetically organized, with slack carefully managed to avoid tangling or interference with components. Grouping wires by function (phase, neutral, earth) helps maintain clarity and simplifies troubleshooting. Terminal Connections All wire connections to MCBs, RCCBs, busbars, and neutral/earth terminals must be firm, tight, and secure, often using spring washers to prevent loosening over time. Protective earth connections are critical; a loose or missing earth can make the metal enclosure live during a fault, creating a serious safety hazard. Color Coding and Standards Follow standard wire color codes for three-phase or single-phase systems: for example, Phase A – Yellow, Phase B – Green, Phase C – Red, Neutral – Light Blue,...
