Ensure your router supports gigabit speeds or higher and that the Ethernet cable from the ONT is connected to the router's designated WAN port. Environmental Factors Extreme temperatures, moisture, or poor ventilation can affect both the ONT and router performance. Ensure devices are placed in a dry, well-ventilated area and powered continuously, ideally with a surge protector. Troubleshooting Steps Verify the fiber cable is securely connected to the ONT and free of damage. Check that the ONT is powered on and the status lights indicate a stable connection. Connect the ONT's Ethernet output to the router's WAN port using a high-quality Cat6a or higher cable. Restart both the ONT and router to resolve tem...
