- Update Firmware:** Ensure your router's firmware is up to date via the router app or web interface, as outdated firmware can cause connectivity problems.
- Contact ISP Support:** If the red light persists after these steps, contact your ISP to verify if the connection is visible on their end and to request further assistance.
