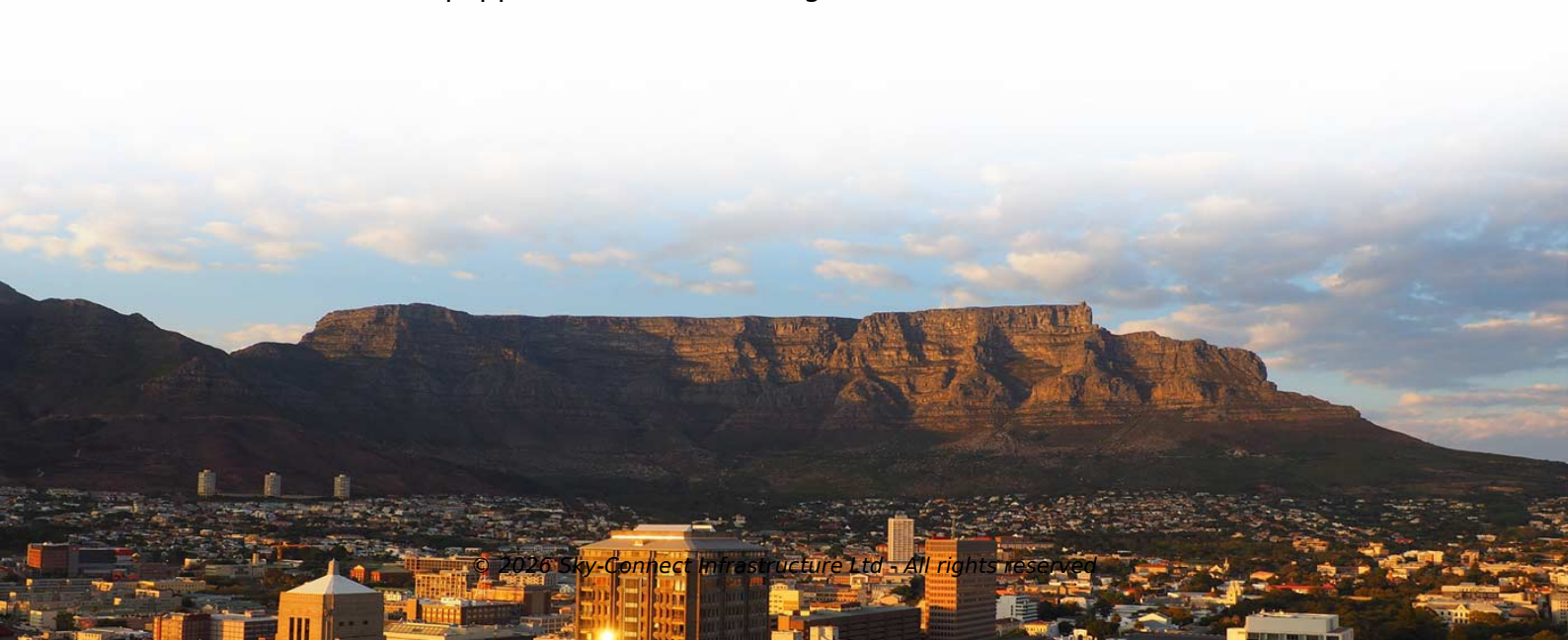


Sealing holes in electrical distribution box components



Overview

Non-hardening electrical putty, also known as duct seal compound or mastic, is the preferred material for sealing wire entries directly inside the box. This pliable, non-toxic compound is easily molded by hand to form a plug around the wire bundle where it passes through the back. An open knockout hole in an electrical box, a missing breaker in a panel, or a damaged cover on a junction box may look like a minor maintenance issue, but each one is a recognized electrical safety hazard. This practice is a fundamental part of maintaining a structure's envelope. It prevents the uncontrolled movement of air, moisture, and. Seal an electrical enclosure by matching the IP/NEMA rating, using the right gasket, cable glands, sealant, and inspection steps to block dust, water, and corrosion. A reliable seal protects the door, gasket, cable. Selecting the appropriate materials is key to effectively air-sealing electrical boxes. And the control cabinet standard DIN EN 61439 (IEC 61439) stipulates that control cabinets must be equipped with a seamless gasket.
