

Sealing of multiple openings in cable trays



AI Overview

Openings in cable trays should be sealed using fire-rated or weatherproof materials to ensure safety, prevent fire and smoke spread, and maintain environmental protection.

Firestopping Requirements When cable trays pass through walls, floors, or slabs, all openings must be tightly sealed with firestopping materials to comply with design and safety standards. The seal must be reliable, without visible cracks or voids, and for large openings, a fire-resistant backing plate should be installed before sealing. Common fire protection materials include fire-rated boards, firestop packs, firestop mastic, and fire-resistant mineral wool. Gaps between firestop packs and cables should not exceed 1 cm², and packing thickness should meet minimum design requirements, typically around 24 cm.

Fireproof Pillows and Intumescent Solutions Products like AF Bags are intumescent and ablative fireproof pillows certified under EN 1366-3, capable of sealing cable tray penetrations up to EI 240. They are designed to fit even thin structures without additional framing and can be repositioned for maintenance. The sealing depth for cables up to 21 mm in diameter is typically 120 mm, and multiple pillows can be used to completely close larger penetrations.

Weatherproof and Environmental Seals For outdoor or wet environments, CSD WSP weatherstops provide a waterproof and corrosion-resistant seal around cable trays, conduits, or bus ducts. These systems use a steel frame with layered water-resistant pads and silicone-based sealant, ensuring a weathertight seal while allowing easy cable maintenance.
