- Switch Box (Tertiary Distribution Box): Delivers power to individual equipment or units, often with single-phase circuits and local protection.

Safety and Protection The system employs a two-level protection approach. Leakage protection devices are installed both in the switch box and in the secondary distribution box to ensure safety. The principle of “one machine, one switch, one RCD, one box, one lock” ensures that each device is independently protected and controlled, preventing a single fault from affecting multiple devices.
