 - Trench installation:** Dig a trench with sand or soft-soil bedding to protect the cable jacket. Depth typically ranges from 24 to 36 inches depending on local regulations and mechanical risk.
 - Vibratory plow:** Suitable for long, open runs with minimal obstacles, reducing labor and civil work costs. Plan for proper backfill and compaction to avoid future cable stress or bending.
- Standards and Testing**

Follow ITU-T L.101 and IEC 60794-3-11 for performance criteria, including tensile strength, crush resistance, and water-blocking tests. Ensure electrical continuity tests for metallic elements if the cable includes grounding or armor layers.
