The integration of these lines with the transformer stations ensures efficient voltage regulation and distribution, reducing energy losses and improving grid reliability. Workforce Training and Expertise Transfer Local teams are receiving comprehensive training from VINCI Energies' French and Moroccan subsidiaries.
