AI Overview

Figure-8 and ADSS cables are two main types of aerial optical fiber cables, with figure-8 using an integrated messenger wire for mechanical support and ADSS being all-dielectric and self-supporting. Construction and Design ADSS (All-Dielectric Self-Supporting) cables are metal-free, lightweight, and designed to support their own weight between poles without a separate messenger wire. They consist of optical fibers inside gel-filled loose tubes, stranded around a non-metallic central strength member made of fiberglass-reinforced plastic, and reinforced with aramid yarn for tensile strength, all protected by a polyethylene outer jacket. This design makes ADSS immune to electromagnetic interference and suitable for installation near high-voltage power lines. Figure-8 cables have a distinctive “8”-shaped cross-section, combining optical fibers with an integrated steel messenger wire. The messenger wire bears the mechanical load, allowing the cable to be strung efficiently between poles. This design is simpler to install and cost-effective for shorter spans, but the steel wire is prone to corrosion and is not recommended near high-voltage lines. Mechanical and Environmental Performance ADSS cables support longer spans (up to 1 km or more), are corrosion-resistant, and perform well in harsh environments, including coastal areas and high-voltage zones. They require specialized hardware and planning for installation but offer lower lifetime total cost due to durability. Figure-8 cables are heavier due to the steel messenger, suitable for shorter spans (typically under 500 meters), and easier to install with simpler hardware. They are ideal for mild climates and urban or rural telecom deployments but require careful tensioning to control sag. Applications in Serbia In Serbia, figure-8 cables are commonly used for telecom aerial deployments where spans are moderate and installation simplicity is prioritized. ADSS cables are preferred for utility networks or areas with high-voltage power lines, long spans, or exposure to lightning and electri...
