Enable Bridge Mode: Activate the setting. Some routers may require you to specify the MAC address of your secondary router; others auto-detect connected devices. Disable Wi-Fi (if necessary): Many routers automatically disable Wi-Fi when bridge mode is enabled, but verify and turn off any remaining wireless radios to prevent conflicts. Connect Your Router: Use an Ethernet cable to connect the LAN port of the bridged gateway to the WAN port of your own router. Only one device should be directly connected to the bridged gateway.
