- Earth Leakage or Residual Current Circuits** Some distribution boxes include RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breakers) or ELCBs (Earth Leakage Circuit Breakers) to protect against electric shocks and leakage currents, particularly in wet areas or for sensitive equipment.
- Subpanels or Auxiliary Circuits** In larger installations, a distribution box may feed subpanels that further distribute power to specific areas or floors, each with its own set of branch circuits
