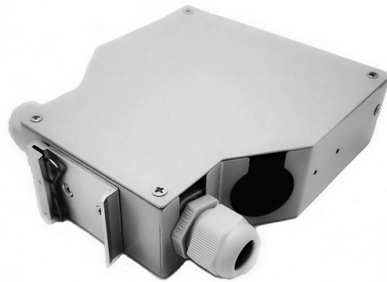


Splitter Port Identification

A splitter port identifier is a method or device used to determine the specific output port of an optical splitter to which an ONU or ONT is connected, enabling accurate network mapping and troubleshooting.

Overview In fiber-optic networks, particularly Passive Optical Networks (PON), splitters distribute optical signals from an Optical Line Terminal (OLT) to multiple Optical Network Units (ONUs). Identifying which splitter port corresponds to a specific ONU is critical for fault location, maintenance, and network optimization. Splitter port identification ensures accurate mapping without disrupting active services.

Methods of Splitter Port Identification

- Power Code Combination Method** This method involves acquiring optical signals from the network and determining a power code combination based on the power ratios of different wavelengths. By mapping transmittance and power code combinations, the system can identify the exact output port of the splitter connected to a specific ONU. This approach is particularly useful in complex ODNs where passive splitters make fault location challenging.
- Non-Intrusive, Clip-On Measurement** Field-deployable devices can measure splitter ports without disconnecting active services. These tools allow operators to verify fiber connections at the Fiber Distribution Hub (FDH) and correct discrepancies between documented provisioning and actual field connections. This method maximizes port utilization and reduces service disruption.
- Commercial PON Port Mappers** Tools like the VIAVI XPERTrak PON Port Mapper automate the identification process. They allow even minimally trained technicians to map splitter ports accurately, update port documentation, and verify connections without disconnecting customers. These solutions support multiple vendor OLT/ONT systems and simplify network maintenance.
- Intelligent Network Verifiers** Devices such as the S120B PON ID Meter can detect online ONUs, verify user information, and identify unused splitter ports. They perform uplink and downlink power testing, and some m...
