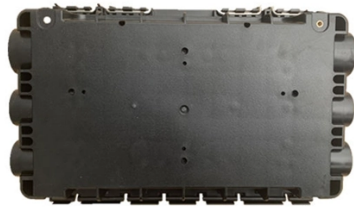

- Check for loose connections: Tighten screws and terminals only if you are qualified; otherwise, call a licensed electrician.
