

Standard Height of Outdoor Distribution Boxes

This ensures safe and convenient access for users. There is no mandated minimum height from the ground, but practical installation typically places the bottom of the box at least 3 feet above grade to avoid water exposure.

Safety and Accessibility Considerations

- Accessibility:** The box must be "readily accessible" without ladders or special tools.
- Protection from water and dirt:** Outdoor boxes should be installed away from wet areas and elevated to prevent flooding or dirt accumulation.
- Physical protection:** Ensure the box is not in the path of lawn equipment or other hazards that could damage the enclosure.
- Weatherproofing:** Use NEMA 3R or 4 rated enclosures for rain-tight protection in wet locations, as required by NEC Article 312.
