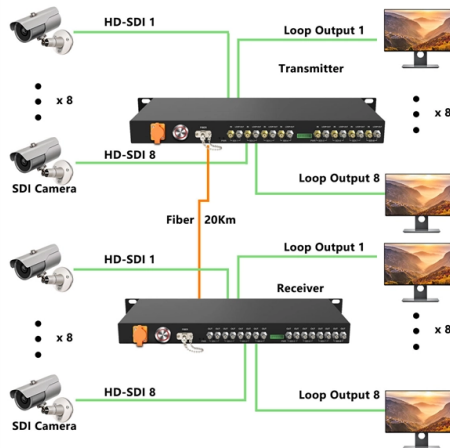


Standard Requirements for Optical Cables and Cables on the Same Pole
