- Door and Panel Clearance:** Enclosed cabinets often feature front and rear doors that open up to 165° when connected, or 60° when standalone, with removable side panels for easy access.
- Load Capacity and Construction**
 - Static Load Capacity:** Varies by model, typically 1200 kg (2646 lbs) for standard network racks, and up to 3000 lbs for heavy-duty server cabinets.
 - Material and Finish:** Cabinets are usually made of steel with powder-coated finishes for corrosion resistance, sometimes including tempered glass doors or mesh panels for ventilation.
 - Ventilation:** Perforated doors and side panels allow front-to-rear airflow, with ventilation rates between 63% and 72%, and optional airflow management packages to optimize cooling.
- Cable and Power Management**
 - Cable Management:** Vertical and horizontal cable managers, trays, and tie points are integrated to organize and secure cabling.
 - Power Distribution Units (PDUs):** Cabinets are designed to accommodate PDUs, often supporting plugs up to 32A, with flexible mounting options.
