These lengths allow for efficient installation in ducts, conduits, or aerial runs, minimizing splicing and connectorization points. The exact length may vary depending on the fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode), cable construction, and manufacturer specifications. Industry Standards Standards organizations such as ITU-T, IEC, TIA, and ISO/IEC provide guidelines for fiber optic cable performance, testing, and installation, but they do not mandate a single fixed length. Instead, manufacturers follow practical lengths that balance ease of handling, installation efficiency, and network design requirements. For example, ITU-T G.652 and G.657 fibers are commonly supplied on reels of 1-3 km for backbone deployment, while bend-insensitive fibers for FTTH may be supplied in shorter lengths for drop cables.
