A standard network rack panel is a 19-inch wide, rack-mounted unit designed to organize and manage network cabling, typically measured in rack units (U) for height. Standard network rack panels are designed to fit 19-inch racks, which is the global standard for IT and telecom equipment. The 19-inch width includes the mounting flanges on each side, allowing the panel to be secured with screws to the rack frame. The height of these panels is measured in rack units (U), where 1U = 1.75 inches (44.45 mm). Common panel heights include 1U, 2U, or 3U, depending on the number of ports and cable management requirements. These panels conform to standards such as ANSI/EIA RS-310-D, IEC 60297-2, and DIN 41494, ensuring compatibility across different manufacturers and global markets. Compliance with these standards guarantees that network switches, patch panels, and other rack-mounted devices align properly within the rack.

Network rack panels are primarily used as patch panels, which serve as centralized hubs for terminating and organizing Ethernet or fiber optic cables. They allow for efficient cable management, easy troubleshooting, and high-density port arrangements. A typical 1U rack panel can provide 24 to 48 ports, depending on the design. There are two main mounting types:

- Rack-mounted panels:** Secured to standard 19-inch racks using side flanges and screws, ideal for data centers, server rooms, and enterprise networks.
- DIN rail-mounted panels:** Snap onto a 35mm DIN rail, often used in industrial or harsh environments where vibration, dust, or moisture protection is required.
