Cable Handling and Installation Fiber optic cables are sensitive to excessive pulling, bending, and crushing forces, which can degrade transmission over time. Key handling practices include: Maximum pulling tension: For stranded loose tube and ribbon cables, typically 600 lbf (2,700 N), but always refer to the cable specification sheet. Minimum bend radius: During installation, multiply the cable diameter by 15 to determine the working bend radius; after installation, the minimum bend radius is usually 10 times the cable diameter. Figure-eight coiling: When unreeled on the ground, use a figure-eight configuration to prevent kinking and twisting, with loops approximately 5-8 ft (1.5-2.4 m) in diameter. Traffic protection: Barricades or cones should be used when cables are placed on pavements or near pedestrian/vehicular traffic.
