Switch ports can be copper (Ethernet) or optical (fiber), each supporting different speeds, distances, and use cases in modern networks.

Ethernet (Copper) Ports Ethernet ports, commonly using RJ45 connectors, transmit data over twisted-pair copper cables such as Cat5e, Cat6, or Cat6a. They are widely used in local area networks (LANs) for connecting computers, servers, and other devices. Speeds typically range from 10 Mbps to 10 Gbps, with Power over Ethernet (PoE) variants supplying both data and electrical power to devices like IP cameras, VoIP phones, and wireless access points. Copper ports are cost-effective and easy to deploy but are limited to short distances, usually up to 100 meters.

Optical (Fiber) Ports Optical ports use fiber optic cables to transmit data as light, enabling higher bandwidth and longer distances than copper. Common optical port types include SFP, SFP+, SFP28, QSFP+, QSFP28, and QSFP-DD, supporting speeds from 1 Gbps to 400 Gbps. Optical ports can connect over kilometers, making them ideal for backbone links, data center uplinks, and long-distance interconnections. They require compatible transceiver modules (single-mode or multi-mode) and interfaces such as LC, SC, or MPO.

Key Differences Between Ethernet and Optical Ports

- Transmission Speed:** Ethernet ports typically max out at 10 Gbps, while optical ports can exceed 100 Gbps.
- Distance:** Ethernet is limited to ~100 meters; optical can reach tens to hundreds of kilometers depending on the fiber type and transceiver.
- Interface Types:** Ethernet uses RJ45; optical uses LC, SC, MPO, or can accept copper modules in combo ports.
- Use Cases:** Ethernet is common for access-layer connections; optical is preferred for aggregation, core, and data center spine-leaf architectures.

- SFP/SFP+:** Modular ports for 1–10 Gbps, flexible for copper or fiber connections.
